

Women's Bible Study




The Women's Bible Study will resume on January 24th with "When You Pray."

Reflection on God's Enduring Grace By Gary Johnson

In 1969 I was deployed to serve one year in Vietnam as a Navy hospital corpsman assigned to Echo Company 2nd Batallion 1st Marines. When my tour of duty was up and I left to return to the states, I did not take down addresses of other men I served with which I regretted. Several months ago one of the hospital corpsman (Ron Bobele) I served with contacted me. He informed me that he had been trying to track me down for over 50 years. He eventually was successful only because he had found my contact information on the Charles County Veteran's Memorial Museum in O'Fallon, Missouri (near St Louis). Two years ago I was invited to be interviewed by the director of the Charles County Veteran's Memorial Museum and my contact information got posted on their website. Ron indicated that he was on the internet continuing to search for me saw my contact information on the website. That is how Ron located me in Murfreesboro. Tennessee.

During the week of Thanksgiving I made a trip to Daytona Beach, Florida to meet up with Ron. We met up on November 21, 2023 and I took him and his wife out to dinner. We catched up on each other's lives and shared many memories of Vietnam, some good and some bad. Ron and his wife invited me to spend Thanksgiving with them and their friends. It was a wonderful and memorable time of lifting up praise, gratitude and thanksgiving to God as well as a time of personal reflection. Such a contrast in time from 1969 to Thanksgiving 2023. So many personal life events occurred over that period of time. As I reflected over those past years I was and continue to be humbled by God's amazing grace!
