From SPRC

DS Chip Hunter advised SPRC on June 7th that pastor Tom would be moving to Carthage TN due to the unexpected retirement of a pastor within the conference. Trinity's new minister, Dane Wood, will begin September 15th after he and his family move from Maryland. In the interim, LeNoir Culbertson has agreed to come out of retirement and work part time at Trinity until Dane begins. LeNoir's first Sunday will be July 7th and she will work on Sundays and provide pastoral care as needed. SPRC and all other committees will work with LeNoir and our staff to make this as smooth a transition as possible.

This is a brief bio from LeNoir:

A preacher's kid growing up in East Tennessee, LeNoir felt a call to ministry early in life. In preparation to respond to this call, she attended Tennessee Wesleyan College and then Vanderbilt Divinity School. She later completed a D.Min at Vanderbilt. After serving appointments in the Holston Conference, she and husband, Barry, moved to Middle Tennessee where Barry began his work as a chaplain at Vanderbilt hospital, a ministry he continued for 36 years. In the meantime, LeNoir received appointments to Donelson Heights, College Grove, Epworth, Madison Street and then to the Superintendency of the then Murfreesboro District. After 45 years of ordained ministry, LeNoir retired but continues to serve on the Board of Ordained Ministry, the Project Transformation Advisory Council, and provides counseling to clergy through Reflective Supervision. LeNoir enjoys traveling, reading, gardening, and spending time with friends. Barry and LeNoir now live in Murfreesboro with their corgi, Cocoa and tuxedo cat, Skittles. They also share their home with great nephew, Drew, as he attends MTSU (it's nice to have a 19 year old in the house again!). Their son, Gavin, is the Project and Portfolio Manager at the Anschutz Corporation in Denver, Colorado.
