A Note From the Pastor



Pastor Dane began his ministry career in 2012 when he started seminary in Atlanta and began as a volunteer and then was hired as an assistant at Lawrenceville Road UMC. He was licensed as a Local Pastor in the South Carolina Conference in 2014 and finished seminary while also serving full time. Pastor Dane has been appointed for 10 years and counting. He served as Pastor to Sharon and Smyrna UMCs (2014-2016, 2-point charge) in Abbeville, SC; Shiloh UMC in

Somerville, TN (2016-2017); as Associate Pastor of Missions and Preaching at Collierville UMC in Collierville, TN (2017-2018); as Associate Pastor at Grace UMC in Baltimore, MD (2018-2021); and as Pastor of Lansdowne UMC in Lansdowne, MD (2021-2024). He was approved for Commissioning as a Provisional Elder in the Baltimore-Washington Conference in 2021 and is expected to be Ordained as a Full Elder at the 2025 Annual Conference of the BWC, after which he will transfer to the Tennessee-Western Kentucky Conference permanently.

Pastor Dane is a proud 4th generation alumnus of Clemson University (2009, BA History), and alumnus of Emory University, Candler School of Theology (2015, M. Div.). He has been happily married to Dr. Lara (Megan) Beers Wood (Ph.D. Immunology, 2016 Emory University) for 12 years. She is currently Research Faculty at Johns Hopkins University School of Medicine where she researches hearing damage. Megan has accepted a position as an Assistant Professor and Principal Investigator at Vanderbilt University School of Medicine, Hearing and Speech Sciences department. She begins in January and her accepting this position was the impetus for their move to the Nashville area. They have two sons, Samuel T. (2 yrs) and Charles I. (3 months). Pastor Dane is passionate about missions, history, and learning how the awesome power of God is practical and life changing every day! He is very excited to be making his way back to Tennessee and is looking forward to joining us soon and introducing his family to us all when they join him in TN later this year.



Trinity UMC's Food Pantry supports people in the community in need of food. We always welcome donations to our food bag ministry: canned goods, crackers, cereal, peanut butter, etc.



Murfreesboro Cold Patrol (MCP) work hard year-round to make sure the most vulnerable individuals in the community have the resources they need to survive living outdoors and are introduced to opportunities available to them to obtain substance use treatment, mental and physical health services, and work to eliminate barriers to accessing permanent, affordable housing.



Isaiah 117 House provides physical and emotional support in a safe and loving home for children who have been removed from their current living situation by DCS and are awaiting placement. Trinity UMC has graciously agreed to sponsor three tubs.
