A Note From the Pastor

Dear Beloved Siblings in Christ,

This May marks a sacred milestone in my journey with Christ and with you—I will be ordained as an Elder in Full Connection in the United Methodist Church on the 15th. As I prepare for this holy moment, I find myself reflecting deeply on what ordination means—not just for me personally, but for the church, and for the shared ministry we are all called to as disciples of Jesus Christ.

In the United Methodist tradition, ordination is not simply a personal achievement or a professional credential. It is a theological affirmation of God's calling, the church's recognition, and a lifelong covenant of service to Christ's body. Our theology of ordination is grounded in the conviction that all ministry begins with God's initiative. God calls. The church discerns. The Spirit empowers.

Elders in the United Methodist Church are ordained to a ministry of Word, Sacrament, Order, and Service. That means we are entrusted to preach and teach the Word of God faithfully, to administer the sacraments with reverence and joy, to order the life of the church for mission and ministry, and to serve alongside God's people in acts of mercy, justice, and compassion. None of this is done alone. In fact, ordination is not about setting someone above others but rather grounding them more deeply within the life of the church for the sake of equipping and empowering all the baptized to live out their callings.

The language the church uses—"Full Connection"—is profoundly meaningful. It reflects not just credential status, but a deep relational covenant. It means I am now fully accountable to the church's doctrine and discipline, and also fully supported by the connectional system of the United Methodist Church, worldwide. It's a reminder that we do not minister in isolation. We are part of something larger—something global, Spiritled, and grace-filled.

As I kneel to receive the laying on of hands and the powerful words, "Take authority..." I will be thinking of each of you and all the congregations I have served. Ordination is not the end—it is a new beginning, a deeper "yes" to God's call, and a renewed commitment to serve with humility, courage, and joy.






